



Princeton High School celebrated its first anniversary of holding the Bellamy Award this year. A ceremony in the school auditorium with many honored guests was held to honor the occasion.







## FOOTBALL





















In addition to publishing "The Voice of Princeton High School," staff members spread Christmas cheer with candy and conversation to patients at Princeton Community Hospital.






